TRANSBAY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Adoption of one-month extension of Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09 Budget for first month of FY 2009-10 in an amount not to exceed \$13,630,950.

SUMMARY:

The Joint Powers Agreement creating the Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA), dated April 4, 2001, establishes the fiscal year of the Authority as beginning on July 1 and ends on June 30, and provides the TJPA Board of Directors with the authority to adopt, at its sole discretion, an annual or multi-year budget before the beginning of each fiscal year.

In accordance with the Budget Policy adopted by the Board of Directors on June 23, 2004, the budget process includes public participation in the form of a public hearing on the proposed budget, held concurrently with a regular Board meeting. Staff had planned to hold the public hearing on the FY 2009-10 annual budgets at the TJPA Board's meeting of May 14, 2009. With the cancellation of that meeting, there is not sufficient time to hold a public hearing and receive input prior to July 1, 2009, the start of FY 2009-10. Therefore, staff recommends holding the public hearing at the TJPA Board's June 2009 meeting, and presenting the FY 2009-10 budget for adoption at the July 2009 meeting.

In accordance with the Budget Policy, if an annual budget is not adopted by July 1, the Board is required to adopt a monthly interim budget equal to one-twelfth the existing annual budget. One-twelfth of the FY 2008-09 Budget Amendment 1 equals \$13,630,950.

The adoption of the monthly interim budget shall continue on a monthly basis until a new annual budget has been approved. The approved annual budget shall replace the interim budget.

WHEREAS, The Transbay Joint Powers Authority (TJPA) is a joint powers agency responsible for the planning, design, construction, operation and management of the new Transbay Terminal; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Joint Powers Agreement creating the TJPA, dated April 4, 2001 (Agreement), the TJPA Board of Directors has the authority to adopt an annual or multi-year budget; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Director's Budget Policy, adopted by the Board of Directors on June 23, 2004, calls for a procedure to include public participation in the budgetary process, including public hearings; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Director's Budget Policy, calls for the adoption of an annual budget before July 1; and

WHEREAS, In the event that an annual budget is not adopted by July 1, the Board of Directors' Budget Policy calls for the Board to adopt a monthly interim budget equal to one-twelfth of the prior year's annual budget; and

WHEREAS, The cancellation of the May 14, 2009 Board of Directors meeting resulted in insufficient time for public input on the TJPA's FY 2009-10 budget; and

WHEREAS, A public hearing on the FY 2009-10 budget is planned for June 2009, and the FY 2009-10 budget adoption is planned for July 2009; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Directors adopted the Fiscal Year 2008-09 Budget at its meeting of June 20, 2008 in an amount not to exceed \$163,571,400, which was administratively amended in March 2009; and

WHEREAS, One-twelfth of the FY 2008-09 Budget Amendment 1 equals \$13,630,950; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the TJPA Board of Directors hereby approves the interim monthly budget for the first month of FY 2009-10 in an amount not to exceed \$13,630,950, attached hereto as Attachment No. 1 and incorporated herein by reference.

Other line items are generally authorized through contract approvals.3: TJPA's grant revenues are multi-year, and do not lapse at the end of a fiscal year. Revenues that are budgeted in one fiscal year, but not utilized, will carry forward into the following year.
