GEOTECHNICAL TESTING WORK ON 80 NATOMA SITE Ongoing through January 4, 2010

| WHAT | As part of the TJPA's pre-construction planning efforts, the performance of two different types of equipment is being evaluated for their effectiveness in drilling and mixing soil with cement to depths that match the anticipated foundation of the new Transbay Transit Center. |
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| WHEN | Ongoing through January 4, 2010 |
| WHERE | Parking Lot at 80 Natoma (between Minna and Natoma Streets to the east of Second Street). |
| IMPACTS | Construction-related noise, intermittent noise from rotating below-grade shaft casings and truck deliveries. |
| SAFETY | Please stay clear of all construction equipment |

As part of the TJPA's pre-construction planning efforts, the performance of two different types of equipment is being evaluated for their effectiveness in drilling and mixing soil with cement to depths that match the anticipated foundation of the new Transbay Transit Center. The results of this investigation will help with designing the shoring wall for the foundation of the lower levels of the new Transit Center. Demobilization of the equipment is scheduled to be completed on December 23, 2009. Removal of the concrete pad and restoration of the site will be completed by January 4, 2010.

Work will be consistent with current work activities and will include intermittent rotation of below-grade shaft casings, truck deliveries, and other construction-related noise.
