ARCHAEOLOGICAL TESTING ON PARKING LOT NEAR BEALE STREET, BETWEEN MISSION AND HOWARD

Monday, July 12, 2010 – Early August 2010

In order to ensure that construction activities associated with the Transbay Transit Center Project will not impact potentially significant historic or prehistoric archaeological deposits, archaeologists will be using a backhoe to create areal exposures for exploration. The archaeological testing will occur in the Caltrans parking lot behind the current Transbay Terminal on Beale Street between Mission and Howard Streets.

This work is scheduled between July 12, 2010 and early August 2010. Work will take place Monday - Friday from 7:00am to 3:30pm.

The archaeological investigations should not generate any disruption to surrounding businesses, however equipment will be visible in the parking lot during this time.
